Dear Customer,

These two mentioned European directions, refer to the limitation/ restriction in the use and waste of the following dangerous and toxic materials inside electrical and electronic appliances since July 2006, in particular Lead, Mercury, Cadmium, Hexavalent Chromium and flame retardants (polybrominated biphenyl – PBB or polybrominated diphenyl ethers – PBDE).
